Fourth of July Parade 2023

The Community Roundtable in collaboration with The Greater Brandon Chamber of Commerce is bringing back the Brandon Fourth of July Parade!!! We are so excited to be able to participate in this amazing community event. All students are strongly encouraged to participate in the Fourth of July Parade. The parade will be Tuesday, July 4th. Students requiring school instruments will need to meet at Bloomingdale High School between 8:00 a.m. – 8:30 a.m. All band members and Crimson Guard (along with several Brandon High School band members) will meet at the corner of Lumsden and John Moore in the walk-in clinic parking lot at 9:00 am. Please dress in a band t-shirt, comfortable shorts, and the proper footwear – socks and tennis shoes (you cannot safely march in flip flops!). The parade should be finished approximately by 11:30 am. This parade is very important to the local community, which supports the Bloomingdale Band program. It is only appropriate that we give back the support to the community by having a large turn-out for this parade. Be there! Any incoming freshmen students are encouraged to join us! Just wear your middle school band t-shirt and jump in line! Music will be available at parade site or you can download it from the band website, www.bloomingdaleband.com. All Leadership (Officers/Section Leaders/Captains/Co-Captains) <u>MANDATORY</u> Preparation Meeting Wednesday & Thursday July 26th & 27th 9:00am – 4:00pm

All Leadership (Officers/Section Leaders /Captains/Co-Captains) will have a preparation meeting for the preseason training and the fall operations. The first thing that I feel needs to be clarified is the role and importance of **every** position and my expectations for the leadership TEAM.

Freshmen/New Member/Full Drum Line/Full Crimson Guard/Leadership Preseason Training Saturday, July 29th 8:00am-4:00pm

All freshmen, new members, drum line, guard, and 2023 Leadership are required to attend the freshmen/new member training session Saturday, July 29th. The purpose of the morning session is to get all freshmen and new members accustomed to proper marching and maneuvering. The afternoon session will be dedicated to an inside music rehearsal. The schedule is as follows:

What to bring and wear to preseason training as well as all evening rehearsals

Wear light colored, loose fitting clothes • Sunglasses • Water container • Hat • 2 pair of white socks • Sunscreen & bug spray

Wear correct footwear – tennis shoes with support!!! Flip flops, sandals will **not** be allowed while marching. **Instrument and all accessories (i.e. reeds, mouthpiece, oil)**

Required* materials for Marching Season

Flip folder and music lyre for your instrument – available at music showcase. 3-Ring binder and plastic page protectors (about 20) for drill Reeds, mouthpieces, oil, cork grease, neck straps, etc. Pencil!

Personal tuner (before you buy one, check with Mr. Fraze, he will have the recommended ones available for purchase).

Personal water cooler.

8:00 am - 12:00 pm Morning session.

12:00 pm — 1:00 pm Lunch break: Students can bring his/her own lunch and personal water container (a parent may bring the lunch to you) <u>or</u> the leadership will take \$5 pizza/soda <u>preorders</u> at the **beginning** of the camp sold by the Band Boosters so please have **\$5** if interested).

1:00 pm - 4:00 pm Afternoon session.

Full Band/Crimson Guard Preseason Training July 31st, August 1st, 3rd and 4th (EVERYONE)

Otherwise known as band camp, Bloomingdale's preseason training will **July 31**st, **August 1**st, **3**rd, **& 4**th. Once again, the *Rajun' Bull Band* will have a short band camp/preseason training to get a head start on the season and it works wonderfully.

Bloomingdale's preseason training will be focused on three main goals: 1) Correct Marching and Maneuvering 2) Music Rehearsals 3) Staging pre-game and perhaps some of the opener. By the end of the first day of preseason training, section leaders will be assigning drill spots, so it is required that *all members attend all sessions of training*. Since school is starting earlier, it will be very important to have everyone in attendance so we may set the drill accurately. Please schedule work and other commitments around these important dates just as you would for any priority commitment.

The Schedule is as follows:

Plan for about a 20-minute dinner break around 5:00 p.m. Food may be brought in a cooler or dropped off by a parent; however, students may not leave campus until the posted conclusion of rehearsal. Don't forget your own personal water container.

While students are outdoors, they will be given plenty of water breaks and adults will always monitor them. It is highly recommended that students bring their own personal water container.

*Just like any class, these materials are required to be successful in band. To keep paper costs down, students will be issued one set of music and drill. Therefore, all students will be required to obtain a music flip folder and a 3-ring binder with plastic page protectors to keep these materials for the entire season. Additional copies can be printed from home off the band's website.

Wednesday, July 26, 2023, for freshmen and upperclassmen ONLY. 8:20a.m. – noon & 1:00p.m. – 3:40p.m.

Please wear appropriate shorts and a t-shirt to be tried on under the uniform. Cargo shorts, jeans, and sweatshirts are not conducive to be worn under uniform and will delay your fitting time. PLEASE make sure you have tried on your marching shoes so we will know if ordering a new pair is necessary.

We are asking for a deposit of <u>\$150.00</u> at fittings. This can be paid by check (made out to BBB), credit card, cash, or money order. If you wish to use a credit card, please note there will be a conv fee added to your total.

THE FOLLOWING WILL NOT BE COLLECTED ON FITTING DAYS. YOU WILL SEE THE CHARGE(S) ON YOUR MYPAYMENTSPLUS.COM ACCOUNT. There is a county charge for EACH student in band for renting the band uniform from the county. If your child rents an instrument (note ALL percussion and tuba players are assessed this fee), there is an additional rental fee through the county for that charge. Fees are as follows: UNIFORM RENTAL \$37.63, INSTRUMENT RENTAL \$43.00. These fees are NOT ASSOCIATED with the BAND BOOSTER FEES and will be reflected on your child's "MY PAYMENTS PLUS" account and will NOT be collected today. You will be able to see these charges in mypaymentsplus.com during the first weeks of school.

Parents, you are a part of the Band!

As many of you know, the parent (booster) organization is a wonderful and integral part of the *Rajun' Bull Band* program. The parents help with uniforms, equipment, fund raising, chaperoning, and just about anything else. It is an enjoyable way to volunteer at school and to be directly involved with your child's education. The first general meeting for all parents will take place at the sneak peek event promptly at <u>7:00 p.m. on August 4th</u>. Be informed! Be involved!!

Communication Communication

I am a firm believer that open lines of communication with the Director are necessary to have the best experience in band. PLEASE MAKE SURE YOUR INFORMATION AND YOUR CHILD'S INFORMATION IS UP TO DATE. Parents and students are encouraged to speak with the Director about anything. Specific circumstances for anything should be done in advance (whenever possible) and privately (if necessary) with the Director. In short, I must be informed so every family can have a positive experience and every student can get the best music education possible. If I can be of any assistance, please feel free to contact me via email. I will be in the office periodically throughout the summer and you can schedule an appointment with me if necessary. In closing, I am excited about starting the season and I look forward to seeing everyone soon!
